**JUDGMENT ENTRY
2021-02**

In response to the Director's Second Amended Order for Social Distancing, Facial Coverings and Non-Congregating issued May 17, 2021 by the Director of the Ohio Department of Health, the Trumbull County Court of Common Pleas Domestic Relations and Juvenile Division hereby adopts this Judgment Entry regarding protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19:


1. Pursuant to the May 17, 2021 ODH Director's Order, "In accordance with the guidance issued on May 13, 2021 by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, all fully vaccinated (fully vaccinated refers to a person who is ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine, per the CDC Public Health Recommendations for Vaccinated Persons) can resume activities without wearing a mask."
2. Pursuant to the May 17, 2021 ODH Director's Order, "**** all individuals that are not fully vaccinated in the State of Ohio shall wear facial coverings at all times when: (1) in any indoor location that is not a residence. ****"
3. In compliance with the May 17, 2021 ODH Director's Order, the Court finds all fully vaccinated persons as defined above, including employees, are not required to wear a facial covering upon entrance to the Courthouse or while in the Courthouse. In addition, there are no social-distance requirements for fully vaccinated persons.
4. In compliance with the May 17, 2021 ODH Director's Order, the Court hereby **ORDERS ALL INDIVIDUALS (INCLUDING EMPLOYEES, VISITORS, COUNSEL AND PARTIES) WHO ARE NOT FULLY VACCINATED SHALL WEAR A FACIAL COVERING** upon entrance to the Courthouse and at all times inside the courthouse unless the individual is in a private workspace or directed to remove their facial covering for the purposes of Court business by a Judge or Magistrate.
5. In compliance with the May 17, 2021 ODH Director's Order, the Court hereby **ORDERS ALL INDIVIDUALS (INCLUDING EMPLOYEES, VISITORS,**

COUNSEL AND PARTIES) WHO ARE NOT FULLY VACCINATED SHALL MAINTAIN AT LEAST SIX-FOOT SOCIAL DISTANCING FROM OTHER INDIVIDUALS.

6. The Court encourages all persons to continue good hygiene habits such as hand-washing and the use of sanitization products while in the Courthouse.
7. Any person – employee, visitor, counsel, witness or party – who is exhibiting symptoms or who has knowledge of a recent COVID-19 exposure requiring monitoring or quarantining shall notify the Court immediately and shall NOT attempt to enter the building.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
